

Once again our campers were able to discover the great marvels of nature in the waters off Biscayne Bay. This year they explored the native mangrove forests that thrive on the salty Floridian coasts. After observing and learning about the great mangrove forests, the campers, with the guidance and artistic expertise of Edwin Villasmil, created a musical play about the ecosystem of the mangrove forests. Reciting a poem written by Marjory Stoneman Douglas, campers, masked as crocodiles, panthers, and pelicans pranced onto a stage. The camper's parents were invited to the presentation.







Swimming and Gentle Fishing

This year we included two more important activities: swimming and gentle fishing. Swimming instruction for all of the campers was one of our largest and most wished for additions. This year the campers were able to leave camp with the satisfaction of obtaining a new skill.

We also introduced deep-sea gentle fishing aboard Captain Wayne Conn's fishing boat, the "Reward". The campers were taught how to fish and how to gently remove the fish from the line and send them back into the sea.
