The campers, donning preservers, snorkels and masks, jumped off a boat, feet first, into the waters of Biscayne Bay. They grabbed on to a long tether attached to the boat. Once obtaining their sea legs, they dove down into the water's depths to observe and marvel at the shipwreck called the Half Moon, a schooner built in Germany in 1908. The schooner sank in 1930 after a storm broke her moorings.
